This is in final response to the request for information that you sent to Southwestern Power Administration under the Freedom of Information (FOIA) 5 U.S.C. 552. You requested copies of correspondence between Southwestern Power Administration staff and Oklahoma Attorney General Scott E. Pruitt from 2010 to the date of this request (December 9, 2016). You also requested copies of correspondence between SWPA staff and any email address with the stem @oag.gov during the same timeframe.

I assigned your request to the Administrator, Deputy Administrator and the Division of Environmental, Safety, Security and Health to conduct a search of their files for responsive documents.

The search has been completed and there are no documents responsive to your request.

This decision, as well as the adequacy of the search, may be appealed within 90 calendar days from your receipt of this letter pursuant to 10 C.F.R. 1004.8. Appeals should be addressed to Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals, HG-1, L'Enfant Plaza, U. S. Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20585-1615. The written appeal, including the envelope, must clearly indicate that a FOIA appeal is being made. You may also submit your appeal to [OHA.filings@hq.doe.gov](mailto:OHA.filings@hq.doe.gov), including the phrase, "Freedom of Information Appeal" in the subject line. The appeal must contain all of the elements required by 10 C.F.R. 1004.8, including a copy of the determination letter. Thereafter, judicial review will be available to you in the Federal District Court either: 1) in the district where you reside; 2) where


you have your principal place of business; 3) where DOE's records are situated; or 4) in the District of Columbia.
